Children and Youth Services

Children and youth are our most important investment in the future. Young people need to feel that investment to be able to surmount emotional and psychological challenges that arise. To successfully learn new coping skills and regain a sense of high functioning in their life, children need access to what feels like a safe place.

Region 8 Children and Youth Services is that place.

According to the U.S. Surgeon General, about 20% of American children suffer from a diagnosable mental illness during a given year. From anxiety disorders, depression, and disruptive behavior disorders to affective (mood) disorders and eating disorders, Region 8 offers a wide range of outpatient evaluation, diagnosis, and counseling services for children and youth.

AVAILABLE SERVICES

Individual, family, group and school-based therapies

Intake assessments and prescreening evaluations

Crisis prevention, intervention and assessment, and a 24/7 emergency on-call service

School day treatment

Psychiatric, medication, and psychological evaluations

Alcohol and drug prevention and intervention

Psychometric testing, nursing and pharmacy services, and case management

Services for those with developmental disabilities, including transitional employment and living programs

Consultation, mental health education, treatment planning, and intervention

All services are available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Crisis Services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
